

An exceptional achiever, the first lady Vice-Chancellor of Odisha, Priyambada Hejmadi has received the highest prestigious awards in both Science (Padmashri in Science and Engineering) & Culture (Central Sangeet Natak Akademi). She has played a significant role in bringing Odissi Dance into national attention and recognition.

The pioneer Odissi dancer whose performance in the First Inter-University Youth Festival in Talkatora Gardens, New Delhi in 1954, led to the discovery of Odissi Dance and drew National attention to this Art Form. She is the first person to give a full evening Odissi Dance performance in Sapru House, New Delhi in 1961 to establish Odissi as a self-sufficient dance form.

Trained by all the leading Gurus namely Singhari
Shyamasundar Kar, Pankaj Charan Das, Kelucharan
Mahapatra, and Debaprasad Das, she has been
acknowledged as one of the finest and most authentic
exponents of Odissi. For her contributions in the field she
has received many citations and awards. She has authored
many books and holds prestigious positions in different
Government and non-government organizations.
