1. Registration & Entry

- **Mandatory Requirement: Prior online registration is a must.** No on-spot registrations will be accepted.
- **Registration Link - <https://forms.gle/HTgCTdnBSZzoACCi7>**
- **Entry Fee:** ₹500 per participant.
- **Deadline:** Last date for registration **April 20th, 2026.**

2. Eligibility

- **Age Limit: Minimum 12 years old.**

3. Awards:

- **Top Runners: Cash Prizes** will be awarded to the top 3 finishers:
 - 1st Place: **₹15,000 (Medal, Certificate)**
 - 2nd Place: **₹10,000 (Medal, Certificate)**
 - 3rd Place: **₹7,000 (Medal, Certificate)**

4. Competition Rules

- **Course Adherence:** Participants must stay on the marked race course at all times. Taking "short-cuts" across switchbacks or off-trail sections will result in immediate disqualification.

- **Bib Visibility:** The bib numbers must be worn on the attire and must be clearly visible at all times.
- **External Assistance:** No personal support vehicles, pacers, or non-registered runners are allowed to accompany the participant. Receiving physical help will lead to disqualification.
- **Checkpoints:** Runners must pass through all designated timing checkpoints. Failure to register a time at any checkpoint will result in a DNF (Did Not Finish).

5. Event Schedule

- 25th April – 4PM: Reporting. (Issue of Bib numbers)
- 26th April - 6AM: Start of Competition

6. Competition Route

- **Start Point:** Burkath Check point
- **Finish Point:** Mahendragiri Hill Top
- **Total Distance:** 7KM

7. Scoring and Ranking Criteria

- First 3 Participants reaching the finish point with the least time will be declared as winners
- **Timing:** The race will be timed using RFID.
- **Disputes:** Any protest, dispute or technical grievances must be submitted in writing to the **Jury President** within 30 minutes of the results announced.

The decision of the Jury President shall be final and binding on all participants.

8. Logistics & Equipment

- **Accommodation:** Basic Dormitory accommodation at **Gramin Vikas School, Koinpur** and Parlekhamundi will be provided.
- Participants wishing to stay independently may opt for hotels in **Paralakhemundi**. Pick-up and drop-off services will be provided via **pre-set shuttle** at scheduled timings.
- **Food:** Meals will be provided by the organizers for the duration of this event.
- **Personal Equipment:** Standard running shoes are required. Road/trail running gear appropriate for hilly terrain.

4. Competition Rules

1. Format of Competition

A. U13, U16 and Seniors:

- The competition will consist of a total of 25 (twenty-five) boulder problems set on natural rock formations.
- Each participant is required to attempt all 25 boulders within the allotted competition time.
- There shall be no restriction on the number of attempts per boulder, unless otherwise specified by the organizing committee.

B. Beginners:

- **Each Participant under this category should attempt min 5 boulders set on natural rock formation**

2. Scoring and Ranking Criteria

- A boulder shall be considered "completed" (Top) only when the participant achieves a controlled and stable position on the final hold, as defined by the route setters/judges.
- The primary ranking criterion shall be:
- Total number of boulders successfully completed (Tops).

In the event that two or more participants have completed the same number of boulders, the secondary criterion shall be:

- **Total number of attempts taken to complete those boulders.**
- **The participant with fewer total attempts to achieve the same number of tops shall be ranked higher.**

3. Tie-Breaking Procedure (Podium Positions Only)

- In case of a tie affecting podium positions (1st, 2nd, or 3rd place) after applying the above criteria:
- Additional tie-breaker boulder(s) shall be assigned by the route setting team.
- These boulders will be attempted under controlled and equal conditions for all tied participants.
- Final ranking shall be determined based on performance on these additional boulder(s), considering completion and number of attempts.

- For non-podium ties, participants may be awarded joint rankings, unless otherwise decided by the organizers.

4. Attempts Definition

- An attempt shall be counted each time a participant:
- Initiates movement with both hands/feet off the ground toward the boulder, OR
- Makes a clear and intentional effort to progress on the problem as judged by officials.
- Judges' decisions regarding counting of attempts shall be final and binding.

5. Grievance Redressal Mechanism

- Any dispute, protest, or technical grievance must be:
- Submitted immediately after the incident or result in question, and
- Addressed directly to the Jury President through the designated official channel.
- No grievances shall be entertained after the conclusion of the round or declaration of final results.

The decision of the Jury President shall be final and binding on all participants.

- 25th April – 7PM: Finals.
